Polish the first few lines. Start with an example or a story 1 to captivate your reader's attention. 2

Read your text out loud. It improves the rhythm and style and helps you spot parts that don't work.

Cut out the adjectives. You can get rid of half of your adjectives. Leave only the ones that add value.

Use powerful words. Let go of unnecessary adjectives and use only active verbs, not dull ones like "make" or "do".

Explain. Use phrases like "for example", "this means" and "in other words". They help the reader stay on track.

Don't finish with a quote. To finish strongly, use your own voice and avoid ending with a quote of someone else.

Cut one third. New writers usually write too much. Try cutting one third or at least one quarter of the text.

Use subtitles, bold, italic or colours. It breaks the text down and the reader finds the important elements easily.

Check facts. Check all the calculations, numberings, quotes, names and years one more time

Spell-check. Read your text through very carefully with the spelling in mind or ask a friend to do it.
